THE FEAST OF UNLEAVENED BREAD IS A SEVEN DAY FESTIVAL THAT IS KEPT BY THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL THAT SERVES AS A REMINDER OF THEIR WALK WITH GOD.

THE FEAST AND IN PARTICULAR PASSOVER IS A SYMBOLIC REPRESENTATION OF GOD CONSECRATING A SOLEMN ASSEMBLY EVEN IN OUR GENERATION.

IN ADDITION, THE FEAST WAS KEPT FOR SEVEN DAYS, WHICH REPRESENTS PERFECTION. THE SEVEN DAYS REPRESENTS THE BELIEVERS JOURNEY IN WORKING OUT THEIR SALVATION.

IN TRUTH WE ALL AS BELIEVERS ARE IN DIFFERENT STAGES OF WORKING OUT OUR SALVATION, FOR INSTANCE SOME MAY BE ON DAY ONE (STARTING OUT) OTHERS MAYBE ON DAY 4, HOWEVER, THE AIM IS TO PURSUE AND REACH DAY SEVEN.

THE BIBLE INSTRUCTS US AS BELIEVERS THAT WE SHOULD GET RID OF ALL LEAVEN FROM AMONGST US AND THAT NO LEAVEN SHOULD BE FOUND AMONGST.

LEAVEN IN THE SCRIPTURES IS SYMBOLIC OF SIN, THEREFORE, WHAT THE BIBLE IS IMPLYING IS THAT SIN IN ITS VARIOUS FORMS AND EXPRESSIONS SHOULD NOT BE FOUND AMONGST GOD'S PEOPLE.

THE WORD OF GOD IS UNAPOLOGETIC WHEN IT COMES TO GETTING RID OF LEAVEN, FOR IT TELLS US THAT A LITTLE LEAVEN, LEAVENS THE WHOLE LUMP. THIS TALKS ABOUT THE DANGERS OF TOLERATING SIN.
